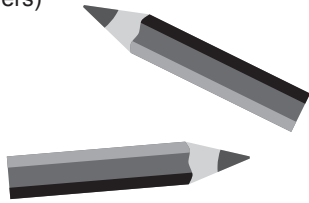

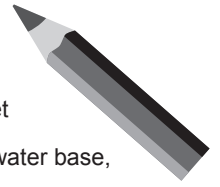
## EARLY CHILDHOOD - SPECIAL EDUCATION
